



Genesis Questions

Instructions: Each week we will cover one chapter in Genesis. To prepare for the upcoming Sunday, you will read the chapter of the week each day, Monday through Friday, and think through the questions listed for that day (Monday is 1.1, Tuesday is 1.2, etc.). We will cover one main idea from the current chapter in the Sunday message. Community Life Groups will dedicate their time to discussing the details of the chapters each time they meet.

Genesis Chapter 1

- 1.1 – List some things you can know about God from Chapter 1.
- 1.2 – What was the earth like when God began creation (1:3), and why is this important? List what was created on each day and try to find patterns.
- 1.3 – What does God command the first creatures to do (1:22), and what is significant about that? What position do humans occupy in creation? Why?
- 1.4 – What does God mean when He says light was created before the sun, moon, and stars? What is significant about man being created in God's image?
- 1.5 – Read Genesis 1:31. What does this say about our world? What does it say about God's relationship to our world? What does it say about the people in our world? What does it say about you?
